Officially she leaves her permanent post at the end of this week, but she is remaining as a supply cover worker and will be with us on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays until Easter. Beyond that she will do supply cover work periodically as needed. Annie understandably wants to have more availability for her family in the late afternoons, which can be tricky with After School Club working hours. We wish Annie the very best of luck in her future ventures, but we will continue to see her daily as a parent at the school.

Parking

Unfortunately, I need to raise a safety matter, as I am aware that we still have members of our parent community parking outside the school at drop off and pick up times, which is creating an unsafe environment.

As a small school we do not have the staffing capacity to patrol Westgate at the beginning and end of the day to check that illegal parking doesn't happen, so we heavily rely on your support to ensure these areas are not used.

If parking outside the school continues to be a concern, we will have to divert staffing from inside the school to patrol Westgate, which will detract from the important work they are doing on site. I therefore kindly request that all our school community park away from the school, instead parking further along Westgate or Hillside please. We are creating a letter that will be sent home if we have noted your car parked illegally. Thank you for your support in making Holy Trinity as safe a place as possible for our children and our families.
